KCC Commissioner Hong Sung-Kyu to Visit Indonesia

- to discuss policy and human exchanges -

Commissioner Hong Sung-Kyu of the Korea Communications Commission (KCC) is scheduled to visit Indonesia from December 9~13, 2013 and meet with the members of the Indonesian House of Representatives, the Ministry of Communications and Information Technology (KEMKOMINFO), the broadcasting commission Komisi Penyiaran Indonesia (KPI) and public service broadcasters to discuss communications policy cooperation, policy experience sharing, and communications experts exchange, among others.

The visit was planned to make a more concrete cooperative channel that enables in-depth policy exchanges following the visit of the Indonesian parliamentarians to the KCC last month. Commissioner Hong is going to meet with the representatives belonging to the first committee of the Indonesian House of Representatives, similar to the Science, ICT, Future Planning, Broadcasting and Communications Committee of the National Assembly of Korea and share ideas and views about public broadcasting policy, digital switchover, and others.

The KEMKOMINFO is in charge of policy-making and regulation of the field

of broadcasting, communications, information technology industry, and post, and the KPI is responsible for technological regulation of the broadcasting, communications and media sector, and regulation of broadcasting and advertising deliberations, and unfair competition practices.
